

REGULATION

ART. 1. Organization

The race "Carpathian Couriers Race U-23" is organized by MZKOL Sp. z o. o. in Poland, address: 31-971 Kraków, Os. Zielone 25, phone number: +48 695 269 696; e-mail: marek.kosicki@mzkol.pl, Cyklistický klub EPIC Dohňany in Slovakia & Czech Republic, address: Dohňany 68, 020 51 Dohňany, Bakony és Balaton Téréségi Turisztikai Nonprofit Kft. address: 8200 Veszprém, Óváros tér 2, under the regulations of the International Cycling Union. The race will take place on 29 April – 4 May 2014 and will consist of 6 stages. Web page: www.carpathianrace.eu.

Co-organizers of the race are - in Poland : Małopolski Związek Kolarski, Urząd Gminy Jabłonna, Urząd Gminy w Ciężkowicach, Urząd Miejski w Dąbrowie Tarnowskiej, Urząd Miasta Tarnowa, Starostwo Powiatowe w Dąbrowie Tarnowskiej, Starostwo Powiatowe w Tarnowie i Firma Reklamowa Akcent Studio; - in Slovakia: Obecny Urad Dohnany, Obecny Urad Stara Bystrica, in Czech Republic: Obecny Urad Horni Lidec.

ART. 2. Race type

In the race allowed are competitors in category Under 23 (born in 1992 - 1995). The race is registered in the UCI Calendar as the class ME 2.2U. According to UCI regulations article 2.11.014 competitors will gain points for UCI classification:

- 40, 30, 16, 12, 10, 8, 6, 3, points for first 8 competitors in general classification
- 8, 5, 2 points for each stage winners
- 4 points for the leader of the general classification.

ART. 3. Participation

Carpathian Couriers Race is open for Continental Teams, national, regional and club teams according to art. 2.1.005 of UCI regulations. Number of participants in a team is 4-5 according to art. 2.2.003 of UCI regulations. National, regional and club teams need the authorization of their own National Federation for the race. Number of persons accompanying the team can not exceed 3.

ART. 4. Race headquarters

hours 13.00 – 19.00. Publishing of race numbers will be held at the Race Office hours 13.00 – 19.00. Team Managers' Meeting in the presence of the Commissaires Panel will take place according to art. 1.2.087 UCI regulations on April 28 at 20.00 in Gizella Hotel*** és Étterem H-8200 Veszprém, Jókai Mór u. 48.

ART. 5. Radio Tour

Radio Tour will be working on 27,00 MHZ frequency.

ART. 6. Individual general classification - LOTTO

Yellow jersey

Classification will be lead according to UCI regulations.

ART. 7. Classification by places - TIPOS

Red jersey

At the finish of each stage competitors will gain points: 1st place – 20 points, 2nd place – 19 points..... 20th place – 1 point. In case of same amount of points place in the last stage is taken under consideration.

ART. 8. Mountains classification - TAURON

Magenta jersey

On the mountains' sprints points will be scored as follows:

- 1st place 3 points
- 2nd place 2 points
- 3rd place 1 points

Classification will be lead according to UCI regulations art. 2.6.017.

ART.9. Classification by points - JANOM

Azure jersey

On the route of each stage will be held intermediate sprints where competitors will gain points:

- 1st place 3 points
- 2nd place 2 points
- 3rd place 1 point

Classification will be lead according to UCI regulations art. 2.6.017.

ART.10. Classification of competitors 19-20 years - NITROGENMUVEK

White jersey

Competitors born in 1994 and 1995 will be situated in this classification.

ART.11. Classification of the advancing – GAZ-SYSTEM

Black jersey

The winner of this classification is the competitor which advances for the most amount of places relatively to the place taken after the second stage. In case of draw higher place is for rider on the best place in overall individual classification. After the 1st and 2nd stage the jersey is given to the competitor with the highest possibility of advance meaning the last competitor in the general classification.

ART. 12. Team classification

According to art. 2.6.016 UCI regulations team classification will be lead after each day based on 3 best times of team competitors and after the stages based on added team stage times.

ART.13. Nominal host country bonus – EPICKLUB / PGNiG

The best rider in the stage in his host country receive the nominal bonus

ART. 14. The order of jerseys

In case of leading in multiple classifications the order of jerseys is as follows in the statute art. 6 –11.

ART. 15. Bonuses

Bonuses will be given according to art. 2.6.019 UCI regulations:

- 1) on intermediate sprints - 3, 2, 1 seconds for 3 best competitors;
- 2) on stage finishes (I,II,IV,V,VI) - 10, 6, 4 seconds for 3 best competitors.

ART. 16. Individual time trial stage

3rd stage will run individual time trial at 30 km distance (2 x 15 km). All riders start on the bikes for road competition according to art. 1.3.006 – 1.3.025 UCI rules except art. 1.3.021 and 1.3.023. Time trial bikes (art. 1.3.021 and 1.3.023) and wheels are not allowed. Wheels should be spokes for massed start according to art.1.3.018 Riders start each 1 min in opposite order places after 2nd stage. It is strictly forbidden to cross middle of the road. Each defection will be penalized 1 min, when create danger – disqualification in the race.

ART. 17. Time limit

Time limit is 10% with maximum of 15 minutes. It is in force in the whole distance. Time limit might be changed by the panel of judges with agreement of the organizer according to the art. 2.6.032.

ART.18. Neutral technical service

Organizer ensures 3 neutral vehicles with standard equipment. On the last mountain premium in the race (Kokocz) – 4 neutral boxes.

ART. 19. Antidoping control

The UCI antidoping regulations are entirely applicable to the event. Moreover and in conformity with the law of Hungary, Slovakia, Czech Republic and Poland, the nationals' law and antidoping regulations are applicable in addition to the UCI antidoping regulations.

ART. 20. Official ceremonies

According to art. 1.2.112 UCI regulations for the decoration 5-10 minutes after arrival to the finish after each stage 3 best competitors in the stage, leaders of individual, points, mountain classifications and the best rider of host country are obliged to report. 15 minutes before the start of each stage will take place presentation of leaders of competitors 19-20 years old classification, places classification, advancing classification and team winners of the previous stage.

ART. 21. Penalties

Penalties according to UCI regulations.

ART. 22. Accommodation and meals

Organizer assures accommodation and meals for the teams on April 28 (dinner) to May 4 (lunch) at organizer's costs.

ART. 23. Safety of riders

Race will be played in limited road traffic - lateral and opposite traffic is closed for the time of passage of the leading riders and peleton. Riders behind the main group are obligated to ride at the right side of the route. Individual time trial in closed traffic.

Race participants need to include self insurance and vehicles insurance on their own.
